

# Caledonia Golf & Fish Club and True Blue Plantation named to Top 100

Caledonia Golf & Fish Club and True Blue Plantation were recently named to GolfLink.com's 2008 "Top 100 Courses" ranking, with Caledonia rated at No. 15 and True Blue at No. 38. The two Mike Strantz-designed courses were two of only four South Carolina golf courses named to the prestigious list and the only Myrtle Beach area courses honored.
